EQUIPMENT

THIOKOL 1201-B. A modified Thiokol Spryte with an oversized engine, aluminum tracks and a fully enclosed metal cab. This machine will seat ten people plus a guide and driver.

TUCKER 400 SNOCAT. Fully enclosed Tucker SnoCat seats six people plus a guide and driver.

TOURS

Advance reservations are required and will be accepted specifically for either the Thiokol 1201-B or the Tucker 400 SnoCat. Groups reserving the Thiokol will be limited to ten for a total cost of \$150 per day. The Tucker is limited to six persons with a daily rental of \$100. A 30% deposit is required with your reservations and the balance due at time of embarking on tour. Tour price is based on the machine used, not the number of persons in the tour group.

All groups will be accompanied by a guide who at all times will be in radio contact with the base area and all machines. The guide will tailor each Powder Tour to his individual group. Each day's tour will cover the best trails for the group as indicated by the existing snow conditions. Currently, 18 trails (approximately 12 miles of skiing) have been cut and are available for your skiing enjoyment on Copper Mountain.

Tours will leave the base area of the mountain at 9:00 a.m. The last trip from the bottom of the area will be no later than 4:00 p.m. If a tour group has not arrived by 10:00 a.m., the tour will be cancelled and the deposit forfeited.

Warming and eating areas and toilet facilities are available in the main Copper Mountain shop area. Groups participating in tours should bring their own lunch.
